

FAQ 1 GIFTS FROM OTHER CHARITIES

Our church sometimes receives gifts from another charity (usually a private foundation) closely connected to one of our members. How should we receipt such a gift?

A. Only gifts made by a member drawn on their personal bank account may be receipted to the donor. If the payment source is from another registered charity, no official receipt for income tax purposes should be issued.
