- i. The CHHMC recommends that Classis approve the following from the report:
 - (1) **Church Plant:** There's great potential for a church plant to be forming in Bethel CRC (Waterdown), with the vision of a church planter reaching Spanish-speaking people living and working in the region. A church planter has been identified, and the team at Bethel is working to bring him from Mexico for a visit. Our Classis is partnering with Bethel, Resonate, and Classis Toronto in supporting this church plant initiative.
 - (a) That Classis commit, in principle, \$80,000 over 5 years to this endeavour.
 - (2) Act 5 works with young adults, encouraging them to think and engage missionally in Hamilton. Each year they run a program for a Gap Year cohort (18-20 year olds) and a Residency cohort (age 21+). Jon Berends is the director, and is happy to come to speak to churches in our Classis about Act 5.
 - (a) That Claissis approve \$10,000/year for the next 3 years to Act 5.
 - (3) **SOCO** Participants in the South Coast Beach Project engage in intentional Christian living, while delving into themes of kingdom living and engaging with the local community through seasonal full time work.
 - (a) That Classis approve \$10,000/year for the next 3 years to SOCO.

- (4) **Diaspora Ministry Leaders Retreat** this summer (August 21-23) sees the 4th retreat for diaspora leaders in Classis Hamilton and Classis Toronto. At this retreat, the question for reflection is: How can you be a good neighbour, friend, and witness for Christ to your neighbours who come from a different cultural or religious background?
